Post Conference Obligations: (choose one of the following)

1. Write a short article on what was learned at the conference that would be suitable for publication in the Summer Newsletter and posted on www.coloradospinabifida.org. The article could be anything from medical findings to cool, new braces or accessories that could make your life easier, to a well thought out "10 Neat Things I Learned at Conference!" (Think David Letterman "Top 10 List").
2. Agree to act as a contact for others who want to learn about going to conference and be willing to answer questions, etc. via a phone call or e-mail.
3. If the beneficiary is a SBACO Youth and Adults or Parent Group member, they can present (may be very informal) what they learned and experienced at conference at one of the group events.
4. Prepare a photo presentation, organize a group photo of SBACO people who attended the conference, collect materials from various presentations and organize as an informative handout. Include some research about next year's conference location. Creativity is encouraged.
5. A proposal "to be approved" may include significant involvement in planning and implementing an event during the fiscal year (e.g. execute a lunch and learn event, establish a regular parent group coffee, etc.). Significant involvement in a committee or event shall not, however, be considered an automatic qualification for scholarship application. A level of individual initiation is required.

NOTE: Recipients may work together on a project, but each individual's contribution must be clearly identified. For example: a 2-part presentation or an article with photos.
